

CITY COUNCIL NO. 17-70

June 15, 1970.

A Special Meeting of City Council was held this evening with the following members present: His Worship Mayor N. Kaneb, Aldermen L. Gauthier, A. Clement, R. Brunet, D. A. Fawthrop, D. Webster, F. Guindon, G. Cameron, K. Bough, A. M. Lebano, J. Pescod and M. Holden.

Committee of the Whole Report No. 16-70 - Moved by Alderman Cameron, seconded by Alderman Guindon that the report be adopted as received. Alderman Lebano voted against the motion. The motion carried.

Public Works Committee No. 7-70 - Moved by Alderman Gauthier, seconded by Alderman Guindon that the report be adopted as received. Unanimously adopted.

Referring to paragraph "F" under New Business of the report, Mr. Adams was instructed to submit, to the Public Works Committee, a list of members of the Public Works and Engineering Departments, who will be attending conventions and courses during the remainder of this year.

Merchandise displayed on Sidewalks - Alderman Brunet suggested that the section of By-law No. 235,1967, which permits merchants to display merchandise on City sidewalks be deleted.

Eastcourt Mall - Various complaints were received regarding the circus which was recently operated at the Eastcourt Mall. It was brought out that, while a circus is permitted in a commercial area, the parking space for the Mall

is of only sufficient size for parking purposes and, by allowing the operation of a circus, the parking facilities were considerably reduced and did not conform with the requirements of the Zoning By-law. Mr. S. E. Fennell is to look into this matter.

Inspection of Balconies - Alderman Brunet suggested that the City's Building Department carry out an inspection of balconies.
