

CITY COUNCIL NO. 18-70

June 24, 1970.

A Special Meeting of City Council was held this evening with the following members present: His Worship Mayor N. Kaneb, Aldermen L. Gauthier, R. Carrara, A. Clement, R. Brunet, D. A. Fawthrop, D. Webster, F. Guindon, G. Cameron, K. Bough, A. M. Lebano, J. Pescod and M. Holden.

Senior Citizens and Family Housing Units - Mr. W. S. Knox, Development Officer, Eastern Region, Ontario Housing Corporation, was present this evening to report on the opening of tenders for the 104 senior citizens and 60 family housing units.

Moved by Alderman Fawthrop, seconded by Alderman Cameron that, following the receipt of the approval of the Board of Directors of Ontario Housing Corporation and the subsequent presentation to Council the construction of 60 row housing family units of rental accommodation on a geared to income basis in the City of Cornwall by Cornwall United Builders be approved. Unanimously endorsed.

Moved by Alderman Carrara, seconded by Alderman Lebano that, following the receipt of the approval of the Board of Directors of Ontario Housing Corporation and the subsequent presentation to Council, the construction of 105 senior citizen units of rental accommodation on a geared to income basis in the City of Cornwall by Ron Engineering and Construction Limited be approved. Unanimously endorsed.

Mr. Knox asked that the City consider putting in crosswalks to insure safety for the children who will be living in the family units which is to be built on Brookdale Avenue, north of the Parkway Hotel. He advised members of Council that both developments are subject to inspection every two weeks and he expected, would also be inspected by our local Building Inspectors. He estimated that the Senior Citizen development would take from six to nine months and the family units from six to seven months to complete. Mr. Knox stated that the Corporation has already applied for Provincial funds and will apply immediately to the Federal Government. Mayor Kaneb asked that the Corporation, when awarding the tender, ask the contractor to take into consideration, using materials purchased within the City and that labourers, etc., from the City, be given an opportunity for employment.

RE #48-70 - Moved by Alderman Lebano, seconded by Alderman Holden that the Raisin Region Conservation Authority be asked to study and carry out improvements to the Grey's Creek area. Unanimously endorsed.

"Nonsuch" - The Administrator read an invitation, which was directed to Members of City Council and their wives, inviting them to be present at the docking of the "Nonsuch" on July 1st at 11:30 a.m. to be followed by a luncheon at the New Parkway Hotel.

Committee of the Whole Report No. 17-70 - Moved by Alderman Gauthier, seconded by Alderman Pescod and the report

be adopted as received. Unanimously adopted.

seconded by Alderman Guindon that Council adjourn.
