

CITY COUNCIL NO. 1-72

January 5, 1972.

The inaugural meeting of City Council was held this evening presided over by His Worship Mayor E. C. Lumley.

Aldermen M. Holden, J. Pescod, A. Lebano, K. Bough, G. Cameron, F. Guindon, D. Fawthrop, D. Webster, A. Clement, G. Samson, A. LeBlanc and G. Leger entered the Council Chambers from the Mayor's office and took their places around the Council table.

Accompanied by Mr. George Lawrence on the organ, Mr. R. Forrester led all present in the singing of "O Canada".

Mr. M. A. Boyer, Clerk-Administrator introduced members of Council to all persons present in the chambers, indicating the ward to which each aldermen had been elected.

Together with the Clerk-Administrator, members of Council repeated the Oath of Office, signing the forms to be retained in the Clerk's office.

Prayers were offered by His Excellency Bishop Adolphe Proulx, Reverend D. J. McDougald and Reverend C. Kellogg.

Mayor Lumley then delivered his inaugural speech explaining the meaning of "teamwork" and assuring the citizens of Cornwall that the members of Council and administration are prepared to make this team one of the most productive in the City's history. Mayor Lumley went on to explain that this Council has adopted a system of one-man Council committees who will work in conjunction with the respective Department Head.

Mayor Lumley added that the new committee setup should eliminate duplication and place emphasis on specific areas of importance.

It was moved by Alderman Cameron, seconded by Alderman Samson that the program, as outlined by Mayor Lumley, be accepted and the following Standing Committees be formed with the aldermen in each instance being Chairman of that committee:


