


A special meeting of City Council was held this afternoon at the former Y.M.-Y.W.C.A. building, with the following members present - His Worship Mayor G. Parisien; Aldermen L. Keen, K. Bough, B. Lynch, F. Guindon, G. Samson, D. Aubry, A. LeBlanc and M. Holden.

Mr. Wm. R. Mack presented to Council the proposed plans for alterations to the former Y.M.-Y.W.C.A. building, to convert a portion of the building into Day Care facilities. Mr. Mack was asked if the renovations being proposed conformed with the fire marshal's regulations. He assured Council that this matter had been thoroughly reviewed. Council was taken on a tour of the building with Mr. Mack explaining where all the renovations would take place. Upon completion of the tour a motion was introduced by Alderman Keen and seconded by Alderman Lynch that the plans as presented be approved in principle and that they be forwarded to the province for consideration. Carried

Weed Control - Lake St. Francis - Mayor Parisien indicated to Council that he was concerned that the harvesting of weeds may be very costly and he hopes that the City is not placed in a situation where it has to take the brunt of the expenses when in fact we will benefit the least of all the municipalities concerned. It was suggested that Alderman Guindo, as chairman of the Environmental Control Committee should not spearhead the actual implementation of this venture. Perhaps, it was suggested, this matter should be turned over to some other body. The concern expressed was concurred with by the other Council members present.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
