A Special Meeting of Council was held this afternoon at the site of the new civic centre, with the following members present - His Worship Mayor G. Parisien; Aldermen L. Keen, K. Bough, B. Lynch, F. Guindon, G. Samson, D. Aubry, A. LeBlanc, M. Holden, A. Lebano, J. Pescod and R. Pearson.


The purpose of this meeting was to review progress to date as well as discuss the unbudgeted items, amounting to \$688,300.

Alderman Lebano inquired as to whether there would be ice available year round. Council was informed that ice would be available for 10 mths. of the year. It would cost approximately \$60,000. more to have ice on a 12 month basis. The Chief Administrator indicated that Council consider renting or tendering of the concession facilities and that possibly the administration could explore this and look for interested companies. This suggestion was endorsed by Council. The Mayor informed Council that in the near future he would organize a meeting with interested groups within the City to discuss the availability of the centre.

Mr. Bob Laplante, a member of the Project Management team explained to Council that piling results had been received and that some additional piling would be necessary in certain areas at an estimated cost of \$25,000. He went on to say that the piling was two weeks behind but that this delay was not interfering with the overall project.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:15 p.m.
