

CITY COUNCIL #6 - 75

February 17, 1975
3:00 p.m.

A special meeting of City Council was held today with the following members present - His Worship Mayor G. Parisien, Aldermen M. Holden, J. Pescod, A. Lebano, K. Bough, G. Cameron, F. Guindon, L. Keen, R. Pearson, R. Aubry, G. Samson, A. LeBlanc and B. Lynch.

Civic Complex Tendering Procedure - It was moved by Alderman F. Guindon and seconded by Alderman A. Lebano that the City give the bidders the option of either providing a bid deposit cheque or a bid bond of an equivalent amount.

Big Brother Association - Mr. Ken Sliter, Executive Director, challenged City Council and staff to a hockey game from which all proceeds would go to the Waugh family. Si Miller is to contact Mr. Sliter and make the necessary arrangements.

Capital Budget - The following projects are to be presented at Council next Monday for final approval.

Arterial Road - On Montreal Road from Marlborough to St. Felix at a cost of \$275,000.

Connecting Link - Installation of traffic lights at the intersection of 13th and Brookdale at a cost of \$15,000.

Land Acquisition - Purchase land on Sydney Street from 13th to Pitt Street at a cost of \$20,000.

Sidewalks & Underground Services - On Montreal Road from Marlborough to St. Felix with overhead wiring at a cost of \$151,000. The Chief Administrator explained that Cornwall Electric had already budgetted for these services and that they should not object to overhead wiring, although he has not yet spoken with Mr. Fairweather.

A sidewalk on Augustus Street from Fourth to Fifth Street at a cost of \$11,000.

A sidewalk on Second Street from the east school driveway to Anthony and from the west school driveway to Lynwood Drive at a cost of \$10,000.

Sanitary Sewers - All the projects listed in the Capital Budget report for 1975 with the exception Pacific Avenue from Marlborough to Ninth and Pacific Lane from Pacific Avenue to House #930 were approved at a total cost of \$390,000.

Storm Sewers - All the projects listed in the Capital Budget report for 1975 with the exception of, West of City Yard from Outlet to Fly Creek and on Ninth from Cumberland to Brookdale, were approved at a total cost of \$433,000.

Permanent Pavements (Petitions) - All the pavements listed in the Capital Budget report for 1975 were approved at a total cost of \$367,000 with the exception of, Queen Street from Dover Road to Robertson Avenue, Kensington from Birmingham to Windsor, on Jarvis from Walton to First, on Captain MacDonald from Eleventh to Twelfth, on Queen from Wallrich to Dover Road and on Frances Ann from Anthony to West Limits.


Recreation Department - Insulation of B.T.M.C. at a cost of \$29,000 and new equipment at the B.T.M.C. at a cost of \$9,000 and place \$50,000 in current budget.

Off-Street Parking - Purchase land and development of Warrington and Lafayette lots at a cost of \$161,000 and the development of Eastern Business District Lot at a cost of \$30,000.


One-way Street System - Implement this system at a cost of \$35,000.

Senior Government Supported Programs - Allow \$100,000
for N.I.P. and \$187,000 for the completion of Urban Renewal.
