A public meeting was held this evening at the Canadian Martrys Parish Hall. Present were His Worship Mayor G. Parisien; Aldermen Lynch, Aubry, Armstrong, Pescod, Lebano, Samson, LeBlanc, Guindon and Keen.

Upper Fly Creek -

Mr. J.C. LeBrun, spokesman for the residents of the area welcomed the Mayor and Council and took the opportunity to congratulate the Council and administration for the work carried out so far this Spring.

Mayor Parisien informed the assembly that Council had budgeted for Phase 1 of the project \$1.1 million and had submitted the entire capital budget to the O.M.B. for approval. So far no reply has been given.

Mr. Meikle read the terms of reference for the study and introduced Mr. J.C. Anderson, Branch Manager of Gore & Storrie Ltd.


Mr. Anderson explained thoroughly the contents of the report of the Upper Fly Creek detailing the costs of the alternatives reviewed. He terminated his explanation of the report by recommending alternative 3(b) of the report at a cost of \$2,955,000.

After a lengthy question and answer session, Mayor Parisien thanked the organizers for allowing the Council and administration to visit with them and explain the alternatives being studied to help control flooding. He further stated that if anyone had any specific problem with his property or the street he lived on, to simply contact the office of the Director of Public Works and his staff would gladly record the comments and have them investigated.
