

CITY COUNCIL - #16 - 77

Current Budget

May 4, 1977  
7:00 p.m.

A special meeting of City Council was held this evening with the following members present - His Worship Mayor G. Parisien; Aldermen P. Armstrong, R. Aubry, G. Cameron, F. Guindon, L. Keen, L.G. Lavigne, A. Lebano, A. LeBlanc, B. Lynch, J. Pescod, G. Samson and G. Williamson.

Following the explanation given by the Chief Administrator of his report dated May 4th, the Council agreed to retain \$20,000. to be allocated to sewer policy.

Moved by Aldermen Cameron and Lynch that the sidewalk policy totaling \$20,000. plus \$4,000. for a temporary sidewalk on Holy Cross Blvd. be deleted from consideration in the 1977 budget. Carried

At this point Mayor Parisien joined the meeting.

In reviewing the major budget document the following actions were decided -


Moved by Aldermen Williamson and Aubry that \$10,000. be deducted from the service information section of the Treasury Department. Alderman Lavigne declared his interest in this matter. Motion defeated.

Moved by Aldermen Williamson and Cameron that the hiring of an Animal Control Officer and the supplying of one vehicle be cancelled. Alderman Lavigne requested a recorded vote. For the motion: Aldermen Armstrong, Pescod, Lavigne, Cameron, Williamson, Samson and LeBlanc. Against the motion: Aldermen Lebano, Guindon, Keen, Lynch and Aubry. There was not a two-thirds majority and the motion was defeated.


Moved by Aldermen Cameron and Samson that the \$25,000. shown in transfer payments in the Fire Dept. be deferred until additional information is provided. Motion defeated.

After some further discussions, the Mayor adjourned the meeting at 11:00 p.m. and set Friday, May 6th at 5:30 p.m. for continuation of discussions on the budget.
