Adoption of Minutes -

Delegations - D. Markell

Mr. D. Markell advised Council that he was representing the property owners on Dundee St. being part of Registered Plan 240. He indicated that the request that was being made to the Council was that the City consider in this year's budget the installation of sewer and watermain services and also the upgrading of the road. He went on to indicate that this would permit the building of nineteen lots which would represent \$12,000. in taxes to the municipality. He also indicated that his group was willing to provide the services at their cost, but would hope that the City would undertake this project. After the presentation of Mr. Markell, it was

Moved by Aldermen Lebano and Samson that the administration review the matter and that answers be made available for the budget meeting, at which time the Council would consider the options being offered. Carried

#30-78 - Moved by Aldermen Aubry and Lynch that Whereas, Highway 401 traverses within our municipal boundaries; And Whereas, the City of Cornwall is very concerned about its tourist promotion; And Whereas, highway signage is very important in informing tourists travelling our highways of where food, fuel and accomodation can be obtained; And Whereas, such signage is not provided to tourists travelling west bound on Highway 401 at Cornwall; Therefore be it resolved that the Ministry of Transportation and Communications be requested to appraise

its signage on Highway 401 at Cornwall and, in particular, those exits at Boundary Road and McConnell Ave. and that remedial action be taken as soon as possible. Carried

A recorded vote was requested. For the motion - Aldermen Pescod, Aubry, Guindon, Lynch and Williamson. Against the motion - Aldermen Armstrong, Lebano, Cameron, Keen, Samson, LeBlanc and Lavigne. Motion defeated.

Moved by Aldermen Keen and Lavigne that the tender be referred to the Commissioner of Finance for review and brought back at the budget meeting to be held later this week.

An amendment to the motion was made by Aldermen Aubry and Cameron that administration outline a program of signs replacements and that such a program include a cost for each phase of the program.

Amendment carried. Motion carried as amended.

Horner when he speaks to the Seaway Valley Tourist Council in order that the Mayor may convey to the Minister, Council's position in any proposed increases in textile tariffs. Carried

Temporary signs, Sydney St. - Moved by Aldermen Keen and Armstrong that the administration install temporary 'No Parking' signs on the west side of Sydney Street between Water and Second Street. Motion defeated.
