

CITY COUNCIL #24-78

A joint meeting of Council and the Planning Board was held at the Cornwall Civic Complex to review the second draft of the proposed signs by-law with the following being present - Council - His Worship Mayor G. Parisien, Aldermen J. Pescod, A. Lebano, R. Aubry, D. Armstrong, B. Lynch, F. Guindon, A. LeBlanc and G. Samson
Planning Board - C. Preddie, T. Bowman, J. Larin & R. Pearson.

The Director of Planning read a notice that appeared in the local daily newspaper on June 14th & 19th inviting the public to attend the meeting. He also stated that he had received comments from certain department heads and the Chamber of Commerce which will be considered in the final draft of the by-law. Comments obtained tonight from members of Council and the Planning Board and the public will also be considered.

Every member of Council and the Planning Board was afforded an opportunity to comment on the draft by-law. The majority of Council and Planning Board approved the fines structure and also a minimum fine. They also agreed that the by-law was a welcomed document and should be helpful in making our community a more attractive one.

Messrs. Wm. Mack, architect for the Pitt Street Pedestrian Mall, P. Blumel, Downtown Merchants Association, J. Tothfaluse, restaurant owner, S. Renner, solicitor, T. Landon, real estate, J. McDonald, Macey Signs, and Mrs. Linda Kane, J.L. Signs, were in the audience and offered their comments.

The Chairman of the Planning Board advised that these comments were noted by the Director of Planning and will be considered when finalizing the by-law.

The Mayor thanked everyone for coming to the meeting and indicated that when the final draft is ready it will be advertized.

The meeting adjourned at 10 p.m.
