

CITY COUNCIL - #4 - 78

February 6, 1978

A special meeting of City Council was held this evening with the following members present - His Worship Mayor G. Parisien; Aldermen P. Armstrong, R. Aubry, G. Cameron, F. Guindon, L. Keen, A. Lebano, A. LeBlanc, B. Lynch, J. Pescod, G. Samson and G. Williamson.


Cambridge Leaseholds Ltd. - Mr. C. Magwood, senior vice-president was in attendance to give details to the proposed shopping mall to be built on two downtown blocks. He indicated that the Sears store would service a full range of merchandise and would be, thus, considered a type 'A' store. He also indicated that the objective was to start construction in June 1978 and open in October 1979. He stated that he will be making more frequent visits to the Council to keep the members aware of any ongoing changes, as the project is revised from time to time. Mr. Magwood indicated that his company is prepared to consider the history of Cornwall and, perhaps, be able to blend some historical features with our modern buildings.

Council Meeting, Jan. 31st - Moved by Aldermen Keen and Lebano that the minutes of the public meeting be received. Carried


Capital Budget Forecast 1978 - This matter consisted of two reports - one from the Commissioner of Finance, dated January 31, 1978; and one from the Chief Administrator, dated February 2, 1978 which is a request from the Township of Cornwall to supply water to the North-End as well as a request from Mr. Iwachniuk asking Council to consider installation of water mains in the residential area of the North-End. After some discussion of both reports it was

Moved by Aldermen Lynch and Cameron that the Commissioner of Finance be authorized to - a) apply to the O.M.B. to rescind Order #E76194; b) apply to the O.M.B. for a 1978 quota of \$2,170,000.; c) include, in the 1978 Current Budget, \$473,300. for Capital Projects; and d) utilize \$256,000. from Reserves for Capital Projects; and, further, that the 1978 Capital Budget be adjusted for waterworks with an additional \$525,000. added to the figure of \$67,000. to produce a final Capital Budget in this area of \$592,000. Carried
