Festival of Hope


As a result of a request made that the Festival be allowed to use the Handi-Transit service to transport handicapped people, it was moved by Aldermen Guindon and Lalonde that the City offer the Handi-Transit buses only free of charge. Carried

Guindon Park, Tourism Development Strategy

Moved by Aldermen Lebano and Guindon that the City is prepared to defer carrying out the proposed Tourism Development Strategy Study for several months to allow for completion of a private developer's study on the feasibility of establishing a "white water action type tourist attraction" in Guindon Park. This deferment is conditional upon the private developer's study commencing within six weeks and on the understanding that the agreement between EOSA and the City for financial assistance will still stand. Carried
