A Special Meeting of City Council was held this afternoon when the following were present - Alderman R. Lalonde, Acting Mayor, Aldermen D. Armstrong, R. Aubry, F. Guindon, A. Lebano, J. Pe A. LeBlanc, G. Leger, J. Samis and W. Wise. Mayor Parisien and Alderman Samson were attending a Board of Health meeting. Alderman Cameron was absent.

1984 Junior Men's Curling Championships

Mr. Wm. Upper presented a short film on the 1980 Junior Men's Curling Championships held in Kitchener. Following his presentation Mr. Upper indicated that if Council is successful in obtaining the 1984 Championships, the presentation in Fredericton will be at no cost to the municipality; if the City is unsuccessful, the cost will be \$6,124.70. He added that 25 of the 65 area curling clubs have already written to the local club supporting the City's bid for the 1984 Championships.

It was then moved by Aldermen Samis and Lebano that the City support the bid to obtain the 1984 Junior Men's Curling Championships at a budgetted cost of \$8,919.52 and that the City allow eleven representatives to make the presentation, with Council representation to be decided at the Council meeting of March 1st.
