ADOPTION OF MINUTES

Moved by Aldermen G. Samson and G. Leger that the minutes of the September 26th meeting of City Council be adopted. Carried

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

Moved by Aldermen R. Lalonde and G. Samson that Council go into Committee of the Whole and that all delegations, resolutions, communications and by-laws be referred to that Committee and that by-laws 116 to 120 be given first reading -

By-law 116- To authorize signing of agreement with Canadian Pacific Limited and the Ministry of the Environment (maintenance and sewer pipe)

117- To provide for the establishment of a Property Standards Committee

118- To appoint a Planning Advisory Committee

119- To authorize the Planning Advisory Committee to conduct hearings

120- To authorize the sale of part of Block P, R.P. 322 to Douglas R.

Campbell Construction Co. Ltd. for \$8,000 Carried

1. Temporary Pavement, McConnell - Moved by Aldermen A. LeBlanc and T. Lalonde that communication #1 be deleted as the work had been completed prior to the meeting under the budget. Carried
2. Christian Freedom Club - Moved by Aldermen D. Aubry and W. Wise that the rental be set at \$1,020 per month regardless of length of term and that it apply to Salon D1 only. Defeated
3. Pitt St. Pedestrian Mall - Moved by Aldermen B. Lynch and T. Lalonde that no action be taken on converting that section of the Pitt St. Mall between Second and Third to vehicular traffic. Carried
4. Reduction in Number of Aldermen - Moved by Aldermen B. Lynch and D. Aubry that Council rescind its present resolution passed on or about Apr. 11 and that it adopt the following resolution - "that application be made to the OMB for a new division of the municipality to reduce its number of aldermen from 12 to 10. Defeated
 An amendment was moved by Aldermen J. Samis and T. Lalonde that this be sent back to our solicitor for more information and possible use of a private bill. Carried

5. Pioneer Sportsworld and IAAPA Summer Meeting - Moved by Aldermen A. Lebano and R. Lalonde that the report from the Comm. of Dev. be received. Carried
6. Environmental Control Comm. - Moved by Aldermen T. Lalonde and G. Samson that the minutes of the meeting of September 21st be received. Carried
7. R.R.C.A. Municipal Levy - Moved by Aldermen D. Aubry and G. Leger that \$102,099 be taken from reserves, specifically the reserve which was created as a result of the rebates obtained from the Conservation Authority. Carried
8. Heritage Cornwall - Moved by Aldermen B. Lynch and A. LeBlanc that the minutes of the meeting of September 21st be received. Carried
9. Hall of Fame - Civic Complex - Moved by Aldermen W. Wise and A. Lebano that Mr. Upper's recommendations A and B be approved. Carried
10. Second-Brookdale Transit Route - Moved by Aldermen A. Lebano and E. Myers that Council reconsider Transit service hours. Defeated

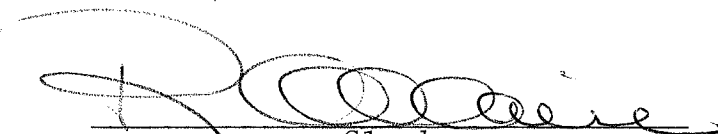
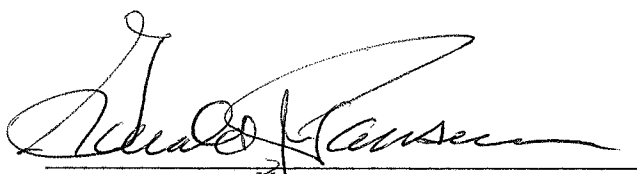
Convert to Rent Program
