

CITY COUNCIL #10-83CURRENT BUDGET

March 9, 1983

City Council met today when the following were present -  
 His Worship Mayor G. Parisien, Aldermen R. Aubry, F. Guindon,  
 R. Lalonde, T. Lalonde, A. Lebano, A. LeBlanc, G. Leger, B. Lynch,  
 E. Myers, J. Samis, G. Samson and W. Wise.

Transportaion Services - Transit

Mr. Adams, Chief Administrator, advised that it was the Administration's recommendations that regular bus service be reduced to one hour service after 6 p.m.; that the Montreal Road run be extended to service Glen-Stor-Dun Lodge and the Training Institute; that the east run be eliminated completely; and that the Handi-Transit service be discontinued after 6 p.m. These recommendations represent a budget reduction of \$230,000.

It was further recommended that fares be increased to 60¢ for children, students and senior citizens and 75¢ for adults. This new rate structure represents a further budget of \$225,000.

Moved by Aldermen Lynch and Guindon that full Handi-Transit service be restored at an estimated cost of \$58,000.

A recorded vote resulted as follows -

For the motion: Aldermen Lynch, T. Lalonde and Guindon. Against the Motion: Aldermen Lebano, R. Lalonde, Myers, Samis, Wise, Leger Samson, LeBlanc and Aubry.

Moved by Aldermen Aubry and Guindon that full service be restored on all regular runs.

Defeated

Moved by Aldermen Lebano and Samis that fares for children, students and senior citizens be 50¢ and adults 75¢.

Defeated

Moved by Aldermen Wise and LeBlanc that the recommendations presented by Administration be approved.

Carried

Environmental Services - Lateral Repairs

Moved by Aldermen Wise and R. Lalonde that a \$300 deductible be instituted whereby each ratepayer affected must pay the first \$300 cost before the City is involved financially. Carried

An amendment was moved by Aldermen Aubry and T. Lalonde that the deductible be increased to \$750. Defeated

The amendment was defeated and the motion carried.

Children's Aid Society

Moved by Aldermen Wise and LeBlanc that the Children's Aid Society be given a 5% increase over their 1982 budget. Carried

Recreation & Cultural Services

Moved by Aldermen Wise and T. Lalonde that this budget be reduced by \$70,600 which includes the closing of the Big Ben Ski Hill unless Domtar is prepared to support the deficit and charging \$18 per hour ice rental to the Cornwall Minor Hockey Association. Carried

An amendment was moved by Aldermen Lynch and LeBlanc that \$10 per hour be charged to the Cornwall Minor Hockey Association. Defeated

The amendment was defeated and the motion carried.

Recreation & Cultural Services - Historical Society

Moved by Aldermen Wise and Samis that the budget of \$55,000 be increased by \$1,000. Carried

Moved by Aldermen Guindon and Samis that one employee be reinstated in the budget for the Clerk's Office. The vote was tied and the Mayor voted against the motion.




Adoption of Budget
