**CURRENT BUDGET**

A special meeting of City Council was held this evening when the following members were present: His Worship, Mayor Brian Lynch, Aldermen D. Aubry, T. Green, A. LeBlanc, D. Carr, G. Leger, C. Poirier, F. Guindon, C. Charlebois, R. Lalonde, B. Gallant, G. Grant and T. Lalonde.

City Council continued its budget deliberations and the following departmental budgets were reviewed: Engineering Services, Transit, Public Works, Sewage Treatment, Social Services and Parks and Recreation.

Engineering Services

Council was advised by Mr. D. Fielding to reduce the revenue budget from \$414,789 to \$402,208.

Public Works Department

The Traffic Engineer advised that the street lighting budget of \$621,210 could be reduced by \$10,000.

Parks and Recreation


Mr. Miller, Manager, advised that \$17,000 should be added to the Image and Attitude budget and \$6,000 to the Pitt Street Mall budget. He also indicated that the revenue shown for Recreation Facilities included increased ice rental fees.
