A special meeting of City Council was held this evening when the following were present: Acting Mayor Dick Aubry, Aldermen D. Carr, C. Charlebois, B. Gallant, F. Guindon, R. Lalonde, A. Leblanc and C. Poirier.

New Transit Manager

The Director of Community Services introduced the new Transit Manager, Mr. Sherman Goodwin.

Municipal Elections

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the provisions of Part II and Part III of Bill 106 and to decide whether Council would opt for Part III or remain with Part II. The Council had in its possession a summary of the provisions, as prepared by the City Clerk.

Moved by Aldermen Charlebois and R. Lalonde to invoke Rule 10 in order to permit potential candidates an opportunity to express their views, with a time limit of five minutes.

Registered candidates, potential candidates and any other interested parties were given the opportunity to express their views and make suggestions.

Members of Council then had the opportunity to comment on the legislation and make known their views.

It was then moved by Aldermen R. Lalonde and Leblanc that Council opt for the mandatory system set out in Part II of Bill 106, the Municipal Elections Statute Law Amendment Act, 1988.


Alderman Guindon requested a recorded vote which resulted as follows:


For the Motion: Aldermen Gallant, R. Lalonde, Guindon and Leblanc.
