COMMUNICATIONS1. Sydney Street - Comprehensive Truck route system

It was moved by Aldermen F. Guindon and R. Lalonde that pursuant to a request from the "Sydney Street Residents Association", that Council approve the following:

1. That a prohibition of heavy truck movement on Sydney Street from Second Street to Sixth Street not be considered and

2. That the existing City policy of: allowing all types of vehicular traffic on arterial streets; and prohibiting heavy trucks from using certain local or residential streets as needs arise, be maintained.

2. Parking Restrictions/Montreal Road

It was moved by Aldermen F. Guindon and C. Poirier that Council authorize the removal of one meter on the north side of Montreal Road, east of the Edward Street intersection.

Motion DEFEATED 7 - 3.

It was moved by Aldermen T. Green and D. Carr that the existing parking meters and restrictions currently in place on the north side of Montreal Road, east of the Edward intersection, remain as is (as per original recommendations in report to Council, August 28, 1990).

### 3. Parking Fines

It was moved by Aldermen T. Lalonde and S. Backs that the fines for violations under the City's Traffic and Parking By-Law #069-1989, be amended as follows:

- (a) all "stopping" violations: \$20.00 (from the current \$15.00);
- (b) winter parking restrictions: \$20.00 (from the current \$10.00);
- (c) fire lane violations: \$25.00 (from the current \$15.00).

### 4. Parking Restrictions - Aubin Ave. and Fourteenth Street

It was moved by Aldermen F. Guindon and A. LeBlanc that:

- 1. Parking be prohibited along the east side of Aubin Avenue from Thirteenth Street to Fifteenth Street at all times.
- 2. Parking be prohibited along the south side of Fourteenth Street from Aubin Avenue to Gallinger Avenue at all times.
- 3. A "School Bus Loading Zone" be established permanently on Gallinger Avenue between Fourteenth and Fifteenth Street.

### 5. Cornwall Bingo Sponsor Association

It was moved by Aldermen F. Guindon and C. Poirier that Council approve the request to sell Nevada tickets in 1991.

### 6. City of North York

It was moved by Aldermen S. Backs and T. Lalonde that Council endorse the City of North York's resolution voicing their concern in reference to the Goods and Services Tax.

(b) January 1990 basic salary of \$30,951.50 plus a 5.5% increase which would reflect a basic salary of \$32,653.83 as of January 1, 1990.
