A special meeting of Council was held with the following members present: His Worship Mayor Phil Poirier, Aldermen T. Lalonde, A. Lebano, R. Lalonde, S. Backs, F. Guindon, C. Poirier, G. Leger, D. Carr and A. LeBlanc.

Absent was Alderman T. Green.

Also in attendance were the following Administrative personnel: Hugh John Cook, Chief Administrative Officer; Paul Fitzpatrick, Director of Economic Development, and Yolande Fobert, Deputy Clerk.

The meeting was called for the purpose of considering a request from Mr. Bob Rae, Premier Elect of Ontario, to delay the demolition of the Capitol Theatre for a period of four weeks.

Having heard a verbal report from Mayor Poirier of his lengthy conversation with Mr. Rae, it was moved by Aldermen D. Carr and A. LeBlanc that in accordance with Clause 10 the Rules of Procedure be suspended in order to allow Council to discuss delaying the demolition of the Capitol Theatre.
