The regular meeting of City council was held with the following members present: His Worship, Mayor Phil Poirier, Aldermen T. Green, A. Leblanc, D. Carr, G. Leger, C. Poirier, F. Guindon, A. Lebano and R. Lalonde.

Absent was Alderman T. Lalonde.

Appointment - Council Vacancy

Alderman Ray Lalonde declared a conflict of interest because one candidate is his brother-in-law. He did not take part in any discussions or vote.

A motion was introduced by Alderman Tom Green and seconded by Alderman Claude Poirier that the 12 persons who filed their resume with the City Clerk be accepted as possible candidates.

It was moved by Aldermen Tom Green and Aime LeBlanc that Council, by way of the Ontario Municipal Association, request that the province change the legislation to allow for an automatic selection of the candidate not elected but having received the most votes at the previous municipal election or other candidates having received the most votes thereafter and that administration prepare a report and recommendation that will allow Council to handle a similar situation differently in the future.

CARRIED


The vote for the nominated persons was as follows:
