CAPITAL BUDGET

TRANSIT - Alternate Route Network

Alderman Dick Aubry declared a conflict of interest being that his firm has an advertising contract with the Transit Department and did not discuss or vote on the issue.

Further to Mr. Goodwin presenting two options for a proposed transit network, it was moved by Aldermen Tom Green and Angelo Lebano that the Transit Manager prepare a statistical report comparing the impact the elimination of the St. Andrews route would have if replaced by the introduction of a new route to service the Tollgate Road area as petitioned for.

TRANSIT - Coaches Replacement

Alderman Ray Lalonde declared a conflict of interest being that his son is a coach operator.

It was moved by Aldermen Aime LeBlanc and Norm Lalonde that two new coaches be purchased in 1992.

FLY CREEK PHASE II

It was moved by Aldermen Dick Aubry and Norm Lalonde that this project be deleted from the Capital Budget.

DEFEATED

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Mayor Martelle declared a conflict of interest being that he has a son employed as a Police Officer and did not discuss or vote on this issue. Alderman Tom Green, Council's other representative on the Police Services Board, chaired this budget review. No changes were made to the proposed budget.

BICYCLE PATH - Power Dam Drive to Optimist Park

It was moved by Aldermen Aime LeBlanc and Ray Lalonde that this project be deleted from the budget.

WOODHOUSE RELOCATION FEASIBILITY STUDY

It was moved by Aldermen Brian Sylvester and Ray Lalonde that this project be deleted from the budget.

MARINA 200 IMPROVEMENTS

It was moved by Aldermen Aime LeBlanc and Dean Hollingsworth that Council reconsider its decision of February 18, 1992 to allocate \$45,000.00 for a portion of the construction of washroom facilities at the north west corner of Marina 200.

CARRIED by 2/3 Vote

It was then moved by Aldermen Aime LeBlanc and Norm Lalonde that the allocation of \$45,000.00 for a portion of the construction of washroom facilities at the north west corner of Marina 200 be deleted from the budget.

CARRIED


CAPITAL BUDGET APPROVAL
