1. Current Value Assessment

It was Council's wish that each recommendation be voted on separately.

It was moved by Councillors Claude Poirier and Brian Lynch that a 10% phase-in program over a three year period for the residential class be implemented provisional on the passing of Bill 79 by the Province.

It was moved by Councillors Claude Poirier and Denis Carr that the treatment of the BOT continue in the same manner for 1999 and the year 2000 but that Council review funding the transfer to the residential property owner by examining its own budget and expenditures.
